Soil Type:

Suited to most soil types from sandy loams through to heavy clay soils.



Sowing Rate:

Dryland hay or grazing: 3.5 - 71b/Acre High rainfall/ Irrigation: 8 - 18 lb/Acre

Irrigated hay production: 20 – 30 lb/Acre
